

IX. POOL

A. Access

1. Access to the pool is through the gate on the west side of the pool fence. This gate is fitted with a lock and requires a key card to enter.
2. The key card is available to property owners and renters, and can be obtained from the Cape Administrator. There is a non-refundable \$25.00 fee. If a card is lost or stolen a new card can be purchased for \$35.00. The old card will be deactivated.
3. Property owners or immediate family members, or renters-must be present at all times the pool is in use by their guests.
 - a. According to Chapter 246-260 Washington Administrative Code, Washington State Board of Health, in a pool with no life guard:
 - (1) Children 12 and under must have a responsible adult, 18 years or older, present.
 - (2) Children 13 thru 17 must have at least one other person present.
4. The gate must be kept locked at all times.
5. Observe the "Pool Closed" signs. The pool may be in a maintenance period and have high chlorine levels. The pool sign will indicate when the pool is open.

B. Registration

1. Property owners or renters must register themselves and each of their guests
2. Family members and guests must be registered separately. Family is defined as the property owner's parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, spouses or partners, or other full-time residents of the CSJ property.

C. Guests

1. Guests to CSJ must be accompanied by their Cape host. Property owners or renters are responsible for their guests. Failure to comply with Pool Rules may result in revocation of pool usage privileges for the remainder of the season
2. A property owner or renter may admit a maximum of 10 guests unless prior arrangements are made with the Pool Director or a member of the Pool Committee.

D. Restrictions

1. No running, pushing, diving or rough-play is permitted.
2. No rafts, air mattresses, surfboards or other large floating devices are permitted. Glass containers, rocks, wood, etc. are further prohibited.
3. Life jackets, float boards, or "floaties" for children are permitted and encouraged. Please take your toys home each day.

4. Furniture, such as chairs and loungers, are provided for use on the pool deck only. They may not be used in the pool or outside the pool enclosure.
5. Do not wear street attire in the pool. No cut-offs, trousers, t-shirts, sandals, flip-flops, or the like are permitted. Bathing suits only please! Babies in clean protective (waterproof) diapers are allowed in the pool, with careful monitoring.
6. Pets are not allowed inside the pool area, and must be closely monitored if using the outside areas of the pool.

E. Private Functions

1. Exclusive use of the pool and pool area for private functions can be negotiated with the Activities Director and is subject to a refundable \$200.00 care and cleaning fee.
2. Such exclusive use of the pool is limited to the hours after 7 p.m.
3. Due to supervision and maintenance requirements, the pool will not be scheduled for use beyond the typical 100 day, 9-hour per day schedule.
